Code of Conduct

It is a condition of entry into the Stadium that you abide by the Codes of Conduct for their own safety and the safety of others. It is a condition of entry that non participating young children be accompanied or adequately supervised by a parent or legal guardian at all times while on these premises. Failure to act according to the Codes of Conduct may result in your removal from the Stadium and / or exclusion.

Parents Code of Conduct

- You will abide by the policy and guidelines of the Bankstown Basketball Association.
- Remember, Children play sport for their own enjoyment, NOT YOURS!
- Respect and support the efforts of the Team Coaches and Manager.
- Recognise the important of Refereeing and Scorebench.
- Applaud good play by all children whether teams mates or opponents.
- Do not ridicule the efforts or scold a player for making a mistake during the game.
- Understand that winning and losing are both part of playing the game.
- Do not dispute the decision of Referees. When children see you doing this they think it is correct behaviour.
- Actively support the policies of the Bankstown Basketball Association and give assistance when appropriate.
- Parents/spectators will abide by BNSW's Parent/Spectator Zero Tolerance Policy and guidelines on sports rage.
- Encourage children to participate if they are interested. If they are not, don't force them.
- Encourage children to always play by the rules.
- Set a good example by your own conduct, behaviour and appearance.
- Do not criticise opposing team members or supporters by work or gesture
- Support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from sporting activities
- Avoid use of derogatory language based on gender, race or impairment.
- You will abide by the policy and guidelines of the statutory requirements of the NSW legislation in relation to child protection and BNSW's sports rage guidelines
