It is a condition of entry that non participating young children be accompanied or adequately supervised by a parent or legal guardian at all times while on these premises. Failure to act according to the Codes of Conduct may result in your removal from the Stadium and / or exclusion.

Players Code of Conduct

- You will abide by the policy and guidelines of the Bankstown Basketball Association.
- Remember your first reason for playing is enjoyment ~ that's what made you start playing basketball.
- Know the rules of basketball and play according to the rules and the spirit of the rule.
- Never dispute or argue with the Referees decision
- Be a Good Sport. Recognise and applaud good play by your team mates and your opponents.
- Remember basketball is a team game and success comes from working with your team mates in offence and defence.
- Respect the time and effort put in by Coaches, Managers and Parents and appreciate the efforts of the Referees.
- Remember that the reputation of your local Club Team and the Bankstown Bruins Association is influenced by how you behave on and off the court.
- Control your temper. Verbal abuse of officials or other players, deliberately distracting or provoking an opponent is not acceptable or permitted in basketball.
- Treat all players, as you would like to be treated. Do not interfere with, bully or take unfair advantage of another player
- Co-operate with your coach, teammates and opponents. Without them there would be no competition.
- Be prepared to lose sometimes. Everyone wins and loses at some time. Be a fair winner and a good loser.
- Avoid us or derogatory language based on gender, race or impairment.
- You will abide by the policy and guidelines of the statutory requirements of the NSW legislation in relation to child protection and BNSW's sports rage guidelines.
