



[Update on Coronavirus 05/11/21: Bankstown Basketball Association Response](#)

Dear Members, Players and Parents,

In light of the recent directive from the Premier of NSW – Dominic Perrottet about relaxing protocols for the fully vaccinated. Therefore commencing Monday, 15th November the following changes to the Association's position on access to the stadium for **FULLY VACCINATED, MEDICALLY EXEMPT AND CHILDREN U16 YEARS of AGE.**

From Monday 15th November 2021 the following changes will occur:

Skills and Development Classes – 17th November:

- 1 Spectator per enrolled child
- Siblings allowed
- Players/Parents continue to wait outside until the first class has exited the stadium.

Junior Competitions – Friday night & Saturday – 19/20th November

- Only 1 x Spectator per player as currently in place
- Siblings allowed if they are required to bring them.
- Players/parents not required to wait outside. Can come in when they arrive.

Senior Competitions – Monday/Wednesday/Thursday and Sunday – 15/17/18/21 November

- Senior Competitions to be allowed 1 spectator per player

For Unvaccinated community members the stadium will now be **inaccessible until Wednesday 15th December 2021.**

This will impact any teams/ players or rep trialling players that had planned to attend after the initial 1st December access date. Please contact the relevant department manager for information of how the Association will move forward from this decision.

The AGM will still go ahead on the Tuesday, 30th November in the Lair with face masks compulsory and social distance spacing of the chairs.

We encourage anyone who is feeling unwell or has a known COVID close contact case to remain away from the stadium until the seven (7) day self-isolation period has expired or has received a negative COVID test result.

We thank everyone for respecting the safety procedures in place to keep the stadium and the staff as safe as possible.
