



[Update on Coronavirus 10/1/22: Bankstown Basketball Association Response](#)

Dear Members, Players and Parents,

From Monday 10th January 2022 as the NSW Government has reinstated the COVID restrictions surrounding indoor venue occupancy. The Associations position is as follows:

- QR Code registration upon arrival.
- Face masks are mandatory in the stadium when entering, spectating and leaving the stadium. Players can remove while competing in games.
- Encourage spectators to social distance while inside the stadium
- Unvaccinated community members are welcome into the stadium to compete or spectate.
- Unlimited spectators (mask compulsory) for the Senior Competition Night.
- Junior Competition – One (1) spectator per child and siblings are allowed (once season recommences on the 28th January 2022)

The Association will no longer initiate a bio-safety officer at the front entrance to protect staff members from potential infectious visitors. While the staff will police face masks, we are requesting patrons take self-responsibility to their own safety, health practices and respect for other patrons by wearing a mask as much as they can. Also, once your game/training has finished to exit the stadium immediately via the doors at the end of court 1. This will eliminate potential cross infection of time periods of competition/ training times.

Management has enabled staff to work remotely to provide a level of protection, therefore staff may not answer messages left on their phones for a few days. Emails will be the best form of communication to ensure the respective staff member receives your request for contact.

Thank you for your abiding by the Association's COVID safety requests and we hope you stay as safe as possible.
